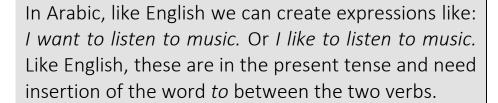
## Conversation: I want to..



In Arabic, we do this by using the filler particle نان. This is shown below. Notice that the verb following أن gets a fat-Ha.

- 1. Read these expressions and use them in a conversation.
  - Meeting new friends / introducing yourself
  - Going to a restaurant
  - Ordering
  - Talking about your likes and dislikes
  - Commenting on the food / restaurant
  - Greetings and going home.



NB: To create a negative statement like (I do not drink coffee), put \( \sqrt{in front of the verb.} \)
